Proposed Concept. "Pieces of HOPE"

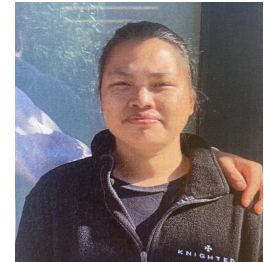


Lance, a "young person" who is a part of Trinity Center has a unique story of travel. He says he keeps himself going by telling himself "Onward"
